
Summer Term Newsletter

English

During this term, we will be carrying out lots of fun reading and writing activities. In English, the children will be writing a non-chronological report and a persuasive letter as well as reading 'Charlotte's Web', to help us to learn about life on a farm.



We are looking at improving fluency in reading. We are trying to encourage the children to read at a quicker pace whilst still gaining an understanding of the text.

You can support your child with this at home by reading and rereading the same sections of your child's book in order for your child to gain confidence.

We have just started our new topic on the Anglo-Saxons and are excited to be learning about what they did for Britain and the impact that they have made on life as it is today.



Farmers Farming

During this term, we will be looking at the conditions needed to grow specific flowers, plants and vegetables.
