## Year 6 SAT's Tests

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are writing to remind you that SATs week for our Year 6's begins on Monday the 9<sup>th</sup> of May.

It is essential that your child is in school everyday for their assessments. We will complete these Monday to Thursday during the mornings only.

There are 5 assessments to complete:

**Monday – Spelling, punctuation and grammar assessment**

**Tuesday – Reading assessment**

**Wednesday – maths (arithmetic assessment and reasoning assessment 1)**

**Thursday – maths (reasoning assessment 2)**

These are statutory assessments meaning they are set and monitored by the government. Each child needs to complete these assessments. If they should be absent, the school and parents must make arrangements for children to do them. There are times when children are absent for very specific and very important reasons and we do understand this but should your child miss an assessment, they will need to be kept separate from their class until they are completed. Please speak to a member of staff in the office or Year 6 to discuss this if you have any concerns.

Next week, Miss Haskey has arranged for Year 6 to have their very own breakfast club. Children may enter their class each day next week (Monday-Thursday) to join their teachers and support staff for a breakfast cob, toast, fruit and drinks. Please ask them to join us via the class doors and not the office.

We will open the class doors at 8.40am which is 10 minutes earlier than usual. This breakfast club is free to year 6 students and will run for 4 days. If your child already attends breakfast club, they can continue to do so as usual but will be taken to their class at 8.40 to join their friends and teachers. Children may attend without eating if they want to come in and relax or prepare before we start our assessments.
